

Rules for the February 20-21, 2026 ALT Lock-In:

We're excited to see you at the Play-In-A-Day Lock-In Weekend!

Below are the rules that are on the "Play-In-A-Day Lock-In Weekend" registration form, which you confirmed when you registered for this event. Parents/Guardians and participants, please review them again and let us know if you have any questions.

Rules/Guidelines:

All participants must register by Friday, February 13. Late registrations will not be accepted due to the preparation needed for this event.

All participants must sign indicating their agreement to these rules.

Teens ages 13-18 who have crewed or been in at least one Arts Live Theatre production may participate.

Unless other arrangements are made with a parent or guardian, each student is expected to stay the entire night and will only be released to their parent or guardian.

Lock-in participants will not be allowed to go outside the venue without adult supervision, and if this rule is broken the parent

will be called and expected to pick up their teen regardless of the hour.

No drugs, alcohol, dangerous materials, or firearms.

All lock-in participants must respect others' physical boundaries.

Inappropriate behavior (i.e. physical intimacy including hand holding, sitting in laps, kissing, etc.) is not allowed. Bullying and negative behavior will also not be tolerated.

Same sex sleeping quarters will be provided. Lights out will be observed from midnight until 8AM.

Violation of these rules will result in participants being asked to leave the lock-in.

Phones will be collected at the beginning of the event. Participants will have access to phones during breaks or in the event of an emergency.

Be considerate and respectful of other participants and leaders.

Be respectful of the building.

Take care of yourself.

Clean up after yourself.
